near Lowell, Oregon

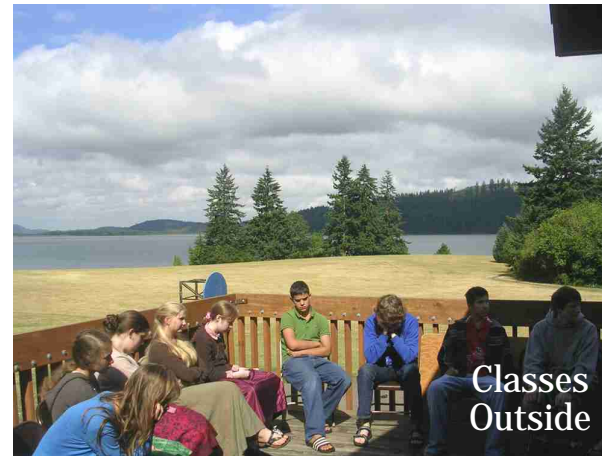
At St. John the Wonderworker Family

we keep costs down.

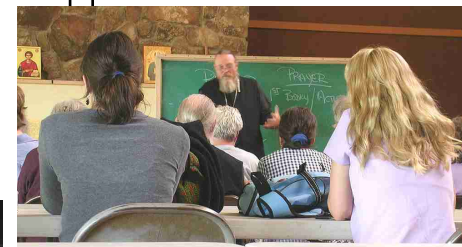

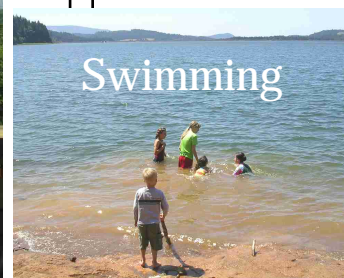
